Overview

Travel the short distance to Wesserling and visit the Wesserling Park Textile Museum for a guided tour, including a private, hands-on block printing workshop. After lunch, tour Beauville Linen in the hollow of a valley, the Manufacture d'Impression sur Etoffes has been refining and perfecting its knowledge of fabric printing for more than two centuries. The finest cotton yarns are woven into a peach-like satin, an inimitable talent to make the colours shimmer, with sometimes more than 20 nuances in the same design.

Spend 3 full days immersed in the talent and artistry of the **European Patchwork Meeting**. The world's finest quiltmakers gather for this prestigious event, situated in the heart of Alsace country in **Sainte Maria-au-Mines**. Take a workshop or two, view more than 600 magnificent quilts on display and exhibition, and shop from hundreds of vendor stalls. This Quilt Festival showcases the world's finest quilt and fibre artists not seen at any other quilt festival.

Travel to **Chalons-en-Champagne**, famous for its hillside vineyards which produce the finest champagnes, and is often referred to as "Little Venice". Arrive in time for lunch and a guided walking tour before settling in for a **Group Dinner** and overnight.



Overview

Continue to picturesque **Giverny**, where Claude Monet and other artists lived and painted. Enjoy priority access to Monet's exquisite 19th-century home, then, with an art historian as your guide, tour the flowerbeds, Japanese bridge, and water lily pond that served as inspiration for Monet's paintings, including the Nymphéas series. Settle in to your quaint hotel for a 2-night stay, and dream of the color and splendor of Giverny.

Rounding out your tour, travel the short distance to Paris for a private guided tour of the famous Paris Flea Markets with Rebecca Devaney. Hidden in the labyrinth alleys are treasure troves of vintage lace, linen, passementerie, golden threads, and gossamer lingerie. Finally, enjoy a private, exclusive, hands-on Boutis workshop with Kumiko Nakayama Geraerts in her Paris studio (a renovated train station!).

Enjoy a final, **Group Farewell Group Dinner**, at a local Paris restaurant.

Kumiko Nakayama Geraerts is a Japanese textile designer who is an expert in Boutis, a quilting technique from the South of France. Her atelier (studio) is absolutely stunning, in a renovated train station called Gare Godillot, located just beside the flea market we will be visiting. Kumiko's boutis designs, completed works, and books she has written on the technique - all breathtaking!

This is a rare opportunty to learn from the best. All materials will be supplied and you will spend a few hours immersed in Kumiko's creative space, learning her technique while working on a pincushion.

Payment Details:

All payments are made through Journeys Connect in US\$ and processed through a credit card.

Initial Deposit:

Please read the following carefully and understand that by participating in a Blue Barn Quilt Co Inc./Kim Caskey Tours tour, you assume certain obligations and responsibilities to Kim Caskey and Linda Timms (Tour Hosts) and your fellow tour members, including, but not limited to, the following:

Understand the physical levels of your tour's daily activities and be capable of fully and happily (no one likes a grumpy or complaining traveller) participate without any assistance — in the following levels of activity:

- Walk 10,000-12,000 steps over the course of the day, up and down stairs, and over unpaved or cobblestone surfaces
- Be comfortable on your feet for up to four hours walking and standing, both inside museums and outdoors in all weather conditions
- Bring one main piece of luggage, plus one smaller day pack or shoulder bag, all of which you must be able to carry yourself, sometimes up stairs
- Carry or roll your luggage for up to 15 minutes from the bus to the hotel, then haul it up several flights of stairs to get to your room (where no porter service is available)
- After orientation and transportation lessons, be able to navigate towns and cities on your own
- Be always available for group communication on What's App (not just when on free Wi-Fi)
